



































## EQUITABLE DEVELOPMENT <u>REQUIRES</u> COMMUNITY ORGANIZATIONS & IMPACTED RESIDENTS

- Local and regional planning have historically contributed to increasing race and class inequities (not resolving them)
- Achieving equity for the future requires a new approach to community and regional development that addressed the historical challenges and puts those most impacted by development at the center of that work moving forward
- Community organizations play a critical role in being able to support residents in visioning and planning for their neighborhoods

#### The Mission & San Francisco Anti-Displacement Coalition Planning Principles

- We are committed to a community driven planning process done in an inclusive manner through community organizing, leadership training, focus groups and popular education -that ensures the participation of those members of our community who are disenfranchised, marginalized, and not usually heard
- Our planning process will address the economic, racial, and social inequalities of the status quo

- Our planning process will strive to advance the capacity of the community to address planning and development issues far into the future
- We strive for transparency in the planning and rezoning process and to ensure city and regional accountability
- We will struggle to improve democracy in San Francisco by increasing the participation of Mission District residents in the decisionmaking bodies

- We believe that all tenants have a right to safe, secure, and affordable places to live. We support strong public policies that protect those rights.
- We believe that real estate speculation destabilizes neighborhoods, communities and economies. We support regulation and controls on such speculation.
- We believe that the future of San Francisco as a culturally vibrant and creative city depends on its capacity to protect tenants from displacement and neighborhoods from gentrification

 We are committed to building a democratic, inclusive, and nonviolent movement for social change to advance these values, beliefs, and policies





