



Changes in US Population


Population – Will Hit 400 Million by 2050 In Millions




Trade-Offs Buyers are Willing to Make

As Land Costs Rise, More People Are Willing to Accept Smaller Lots


Smaller lot Smaller house Unfinished spaces Farther away from shopping, Fewer amenities Longer commute to work Less expensive material



Share of Buyers Willing to Accept a Home Farther Away from Shopping/Entertainment to Make it Affordable by Generation




Home Buyers Prefer Cul de Sacs and Simpler Roofs


When Purchasing a New Home, Which Would You Prefer?




